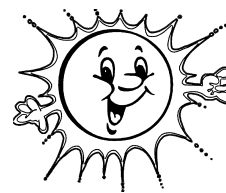

II. On an outline map of World, mark and label **7 Continents & 7 oceans**.

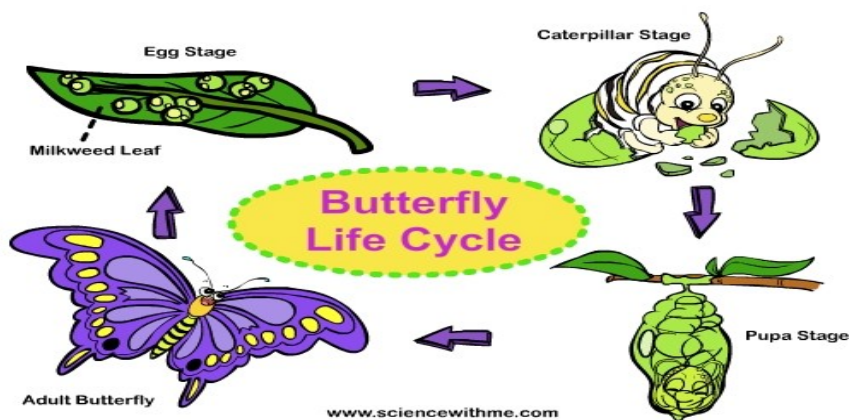
III. Collect and paste pictures of any five monuments listed as heritage sights on A-3 sized sheet.

IV. Collect and Paste pictures of a few adventurous sports on A-3 sized sheet.

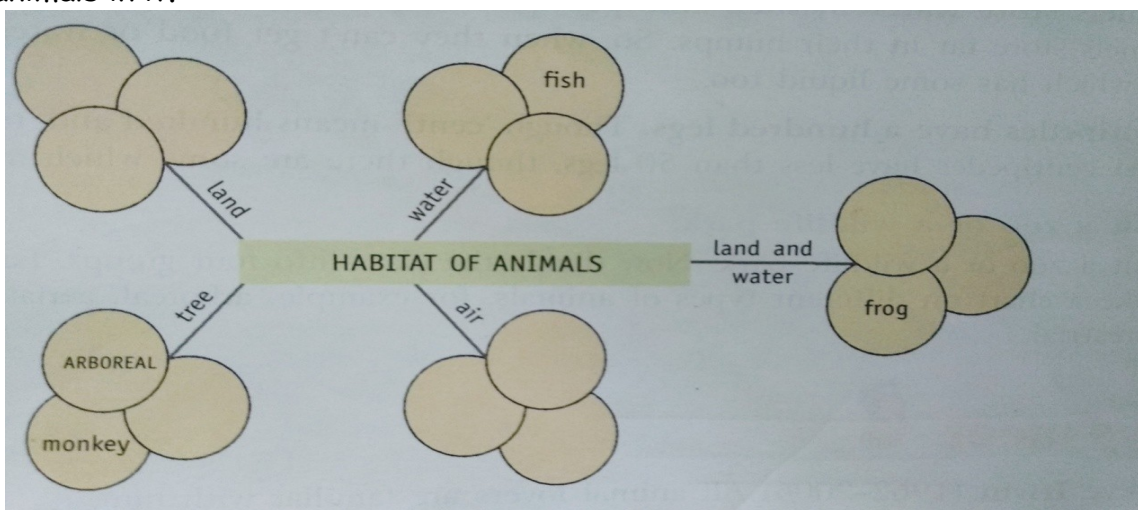
## SCIENCE:
